PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Money Order Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Money Order Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 24 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "of 1s. 2d. if sent at ordinary rates and 1s. 8d. if sent urgent", and substituting the words "of 1s. 6d. if sent at ordinary rates and 2s. 2d. if sent urgent".
