



**MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS (QUALITY ASSURANCE ACTIVITY)  
AMENDMENT NOTICE 1999**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Quality Assurance Activity) Amendment Notice 1999, and is part of the Medical Practitioners (Quality Assurance Activity) Notice 1997\* (“the principal notice”).

(2) This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice adds 9 organisations to the quality assurance activity called the Quality and Safety Study and Improvement Programme run by the Centre for Health Services Research and Policy. The programme originally applied to 3 hospital and health services (Auckland Healthcare Services Limited, Counties Manukau Health Limited (trading as South Auckland Health), and Waitemata Health Limited). It was declared by a notice given in 1997 to be a quality assurance activity to which Part VI of the Medical Practitioners Act 1995 applies.
