THE MILK PRODUCER AND OTHER PRICES NOTICE 1968, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to the Milk Act 1967, the Minister of Agriculture hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Milk Producer and Other Prices Notice 1968, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Producer and Other Prices Notice 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its

notification in the Gazette.

2. The First Schedule to the principal notice (as amended by clause 2 of the Milk Producer and Other Prices Notice 1968, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended—

(a) By omitting from so much of the second column as relates to the period of supply commencing with 1 September 1968 and ending with 31 January 1969 the figures "16.708", and substituting the figures "18.148"; and

(b) By omitting from so much of the second column as relates to the period of supply commencing with 1 February 1969 and ending with 30 April 1969 the figures "20.48", and substituting the figures "21.920".

3. The Milk Producers and Other Prices Notice 1968, Amendment No. 1, is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This notice amends the Milk Producer and Other Prices Notice 1968. It operates retrospectively to increase the town milk producer price payable for the period commencing with 1 September 1968 and ending with 31 January 1969 from 16.708 cents to 18.148 cents per gallon, and for the period commencing with 1 February 1969 and ending with 30 April 1969 from 20.48 cents to 21.920 cents per gallon. The Milk Producer and Other Prices Notice 1968, Amendment No. 1 is revoked.
