PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Milk Production and Supply Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Production and Supply Regulations 1973* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1976.

2. Registration fee—Regulation 38 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$10", and substituting the expression "\$15".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations increase the fee payable for the registration of a farm dairy from \$10 to \$15.
