



**THE MILK PRODUCTION AND SUPPLY REGULATIONS 1973,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 7th day of October 1985

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934 and the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Milk Production and Supply Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Production and Supply Regulations 1973* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day of October 1985.

2. Fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 45, the following regulation:

“45A. There shall be paid by the occupier of a farm dairy in respect of every inspection of that farm dairy under section 5 of the Dairy Industry Act 1952 a fee equal to one third of an amount calculated in accordance with the Third Schedule to these regulations.”

These regulations, which come into force on 14 October 1985, amend the Milk Production and Supply Regulations 1973 so as to require the payment of fees in respect of inspections carried out under section 5 of the Dairy Industry Act 1952.
