# THE MOTOR-SPIRITS PRICES (HAWKE'S BAY-WAIRABAPA) REGULATIONS 1937, AMENDMENT NO. 4.

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS.

- These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices (Hawke's Bay - Wairarapa) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices (Hawke's Bay Wairarapa) Regulations 1937\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 8th day of August, 1941.
- 4. The First Schedule of the principal regulations is hereby amended in respect of the description of Area C by omitting from the heading the word "Napier", and adding, after the words "the point of commencement", the words "excluding the Borough of Napier", and by adding the description of a further area thereto as follows: "Area N: The Borough of Napier."
