THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices District Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read with and form part of the Motorspirits Prices District Regulations 1941* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the date following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.†
- **4.** Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words and expressions " $7\frac{1}{2}d$., $6\frac{1}{2}d$., 6d., $5\frac{1}{2}d$., and $2\frac{1}{2}d$. more", and substituting the following words and expressions: " $8\frac{1}{2}d$., $7\frac{1}{2}d$., 7d., $6\frac{1}{2}d$., and $3\frac{1}{2}d$. more".
- 5. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words and expressions " $\frac{1}{2}$ d. and 1d. less per imperial gallon than", and substituting the following words and expressions: " $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per imperial gallon more than and the same as".

6. The Second to Eighth Schedules inclusive of the principal regulations are consequently amended by revoking the explanatory headings thereof, and substituting the respective explanatory headings set out in the table subjoined to these regulations.
