**THE MOTOR-SPIRITS PRICES DISTRICT REGULATIONS 1941,
AMENDMENT NO. 3.**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices District Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 3.

2. These regulations shall be read with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices District Regulations 1941* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1941.

4. Regulations 4 and 5 of the principal regulations, as amended by the Motor-spirits Prices District Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 2, are further amended by reducing by $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per gallon the prices set out in Scale Number 1 and Scale Number 2 of the respective price schedules contained in the several regulations referred to in the Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth Schedules to the principal regulations as the same have heretofore been amended, and the said respective price schedules are amended accordingly.

5. The reduction referred to in the last preceding regulation shall only apply to sales of motor-spirits to persons holding petrol resellers licenses under the Industrial Efficiency (Motor-spirits Retailers) Regulations 1941.†
