**THE MAORI PURPOSES FUND REGULATIONS 1937,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

Present :

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Maori Purposes Fund Act, 1934-35, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Maori Purposes Fund Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read with and deemed part of the Maori Purposes Fund Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day after the notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked, and the following regulation substituted :—

“REGULATION 7—TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES AND EXPENSES

“(1) The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949†, shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Board or any Committee constituted under section 13 of the Act and to the members of any such Board or Committee :

“(2) The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a day :

“Provided that where a person is entitled under this regulation to a subsistence allowance and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that person.

“(3) The mileage allowance referred to in Regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table :—

Horse-power of Car.	Mileage Allowance.
Not exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$	$5\frac{1}{2}$ d. a mile.
Exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$ but not exceeding $14\frac{1}{2}$	$6\frac{1}{4}$ d. a mile.
Over $14\frac{1}{2}$	7d. a mile.

“(4) Garage expenses payable to a member pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such expenses are incurred.”
