

# THE MATRIMONIAL PROCEEDINGS (COURT FEES) REGULATIONS 1975

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 9th day of June 1975

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 100A of the Judicature Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Matrimonial Proceedings (Court Fees) Regulations 1975.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 16th day of June

1975.

2. Fees of Court—(1) The fees to be taken in the Supreme Court in respect of proceedings under the Matrimonial Proceedings Act 1963 or the Matrimonial Proceedings Rules 1964\* shall be as follows:

(2) All such fees shall be prepaid.

(3) No other fees (except jury or sheriff's fees) shall be payable in the Supreme Court in respect of proceedings referred to in subclause (1) of this regulation, whether or not more than one form of relief is sought in the same application.

(4) The fees to be taken in respect of proceedings under the Matrimonial Proceedings Act 1963 in the Court of Appeal shall be those prescribed by the Court of Appeal Fees Regulations 1975† in respect of

proceedings in that Court.

3. Revocation—The Matrimonial Proceedings (Court Fees) Regulations 1969; are hereby consequentially revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general

effect.

These rules, which come into force on 16 June 1975, increase the Court fees payable in proceedings under the Matrimonial Proceedings Act 1963. The fee for filing a petition is increased from \$36 to \$40. The fee for filing an application for ancillary relief is increased from \$10 to \$20.
