THE MOTOR-SPIRITS PRICES GENERAL REGULATIONS 1938.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 14th day of April, 1938.

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. M. J. SAVAGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

In pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon him by section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby, on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938.
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.*
 - 3. In these regulations—

"District Regulations" means an Order in Council under the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, fixing the

price at which motor-spirits may be sold:

- "Local authority" means the Council, Board, or other statutory governing authority of a borough, county, road district, town district, drainage district, water-supply district, river district, or electric-power district, and also includes Domain Boards, Fire Boards, Harbour Boards, Hospital Boards, and Railway Boards.
- **4.** All district regulations heretofore enacted and now in force shall be read subject to the provisions of these regulations.

5. The respective minimum retail prices set out in any district regulations shall be deemed to be prices for cash payable on delivery, but no person selling on credit terms shall on receiving payment give or allow any discount that would bring the price below the respective minimum price provided for by the district regulations.

6. Nothing in any district regulations shall apply to the sale of any

motor-spirits to a local authority as herein defined.
