**THE MOTOR-SPIRITS PRICES GENERAL REGULATIONS 1938,
AMENDMENT NO. 10.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

September, 1940.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby, on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 10.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938.*
3. These regulations shall come into force on the date following the notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.
4. All prices of standard grade motor-spirits fixed by district regulations shall, on and after the date of coming into force of these regulations, be one halfpenny ($\frac{1}{2}$ d.) per imperial gallon more than the respective prices therein prescribed as modified by all regulations heretofore made effecting any alteration in such prices, whether or not such regulations are in force at the date of enactment hereof.
5. The Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 9,†, are accordingly revoked as spent.
