THE RIGHT HON. M. J. SAVAGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby, on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 2.
2. These regulations shall come into force on the 15th day of August, 1938.
3. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938.*
4. All prices of motor-spirits fixed by district regulations shall, on and after the date of coming into force of these regulations, be $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per imperial gallon less than the respective prices therein prescribed as in force at the date of enactment hereof.
