Pursuant to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby, on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 6.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938.*
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following the notification of the making thereof in the *Gazette*.
- **4.** All prices of motor-spirits fixed by district regulations shall, on and after the date of coming into force of these regulations, be one halfpenny $(\frac{1}{2}d.)$ per imperial gallon more than the respective prices therein prescribed as in force at the date of enactment thereof.
