**THE MOTOR-SPIRITS PRICES GENERAL REGULATIONS 1938,
AMENDMENT NO. 6.**

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby, on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 6.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices General Regulations 1938.*
3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following the notification of the making thereof in the *Gazette*.
4. All prices of motor-spirits fixed by district regulations shall, on and after the date of coming into force of these regulations, be one halfpenny ($\frac{1}{2}$ d.) per imperial gallon more than the respective prices therein prescribed as in force at the date of enactment thereof.
