THE MILK PRICE NOTICE 1968, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1967, the Minister of Agriculture hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Milk Price Notice 1968, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Price Notice 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1969.

2. The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule hereto.
