THE MILK PRICE NOTICE 1975, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to section 25 of the Milk Act 1967, the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Milk Price Notice 1975, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Price Notice 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1976.

2. Maximum milk prices—The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this notice.
