

## THE MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS (REGISTRATION OF SPECIALISTS) REGULATIONS 1971, AMENDMENT NO. 3

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Medical Practitioners Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Registration of Specialists) Regulations 1971\* Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Medical Practitioners (Registration of Specialists) Regulations 1971\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Additional qualifications for registration—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in the third and fourth columns—

(a) At the end of the item relating to ophthalmology the following particulars:

Body

"(f) Royal College of Physicians and
Surgeons of Glasgow

Qualification Fellowship in Oph-

thalmology."

(b) At the end of the item relating to paediatrics the following particulars:

Body

Qualification

"(i) American Board of Paediatrics

Certificate."

These regulations add additional qualifications relating to ophthalmology and paediatrics to the Schedule of specialists and qualifications.
