**THE MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS (REGISTRATION OF SPECIALISTS) REGULATIONS 1971, AMENDMENT NO. 4**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of June 1973

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Medical Practitioners Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Registration of Specialists) Regulations 1971, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Medical Practitioners (Registration of Specialists) Regulations 1971\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Amendments to First Schedule**—(1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the fourth column, in the item relating to anaesthetics and to the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, the words "Fellowship in Anaesthesia", and substituting the following words:

"(a) Fellowship in Anaesthesia.

"(b) Certificate in Anaesthesia conferred on or after the 1st day of January 1973."

(2) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from the third column, in the item relating to diagnostic radiology and also in the item relating to radiotherapy, the words "(d) College of Radiologists of Australasia", and substituting, in each case, the following words:

"(d) Royal Australasian College of Radiologists".

(3) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from the third and fourth columns, in the item relating to pathology, the particulars relating to the College of Pathologists of Australia and Membership thereof, and substituting respectively the following particulars:

"(b) Royal College of Pathologists of Australia Fellowship."

(4) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by inserting in the third and fourth columns, at the end of the item relating to psychological medicine or psychiatry, the following particulars:

"(m) Royal College of Psychiatrists (a) Fellowship.  
(b) Membership."

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations add additional qualifications relating to anaesthetics and psychological medicine or psychiatry to the Schedule of specialists and qualifications. They also amend that Schedule to recognise that the former College of Radiologists of Australasia and the former College of Pathologists of Australia are now Royal Colleges. In the case of the Royal College of Pathologists of Australia the required qualification is to be a Fellowship.
