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# THE MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS (REGISTRATION OF SPECIALISTS) REGULATIONS 1971, AMENDMENT NO. 6

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 39 of the Medical Practitioners Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice of the Minister of Health given after consultation by the Minister with the Medical Council of New Zealand, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Registration of Specialists) Regulations 1971, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Medical Practitioners (Registration of Specialists) Regulations 1971\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Qualification for registration—Regulation 4 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "training and experience", and substituting the words "training, experience, and competence".

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#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The regulations keep up to date the training and qualifications required of medical practitioners seeking registration in various specialties.
