PURSUANT to section 15 of the Medical Practitioners Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Overseas Qualifications) Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1975.

2. Overseas qualifications for conditional registration—The Third Schedule to the Medical Practitioners Act 1968 (as added by section 5 (3) (b) of the Medical Practitioners Amendment Act 1970 and amended by clause 2 of the Medical Practitioners (Overseas Qualifications) Order 1972) is hereby further amended by omitting the heading “SRI LANKA” and item number 30 which appears thereunder.

3. Revocation—The Medical Practitioners (Overseas Qualifications) Order 1972 is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of the order is to withdraw recognition of Sri Lankan medical degrees from the beginning of 1975.
