ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 15 (4) of the Medical Practitioners Act 1968, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Overseas Qualifications) Order 1994.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Overseas qualifications for conditional registration—The Third Schedule to the Medical Practitioners Act 1968 (as substituted by section 5 (2) of the Medical Practitioners Amendment Act 1979) is hereby amended by inserting, after item 31, the following items:

"32. Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery "33. Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery University of the Orange Free State. Medical University of Southern Africa."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order adds 2 further South African qualifications that will be recognised for the purpose of conditional registration in New Zealand under the Medical Practitioners Act 1968.
