Pursuant to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 16.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- **3.** These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.
- 4. The Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 15†, are hereby revoked.
