HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 19, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 3. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:—
- (a) By omitting the words "Sales Area 34 (Set of Differentials Applicable: No. 36)" and the description of Sales Area 34, and substituting the following words:—
 - "Sales Area 34 (Set of Differentials Applicable: No. 32)
- "All that area in the South Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at a point 40 chains due west of Otakiri Post-office; thence proceeding northerly along a right line passing through a point 40 chains due west of Matata Post-office to the sea-coast; thence easterly along the sea-coast to a point due north of Thornton Post-office; thence south-westerly along a right line to a point 40 chains due west of Otakiri, the point of commencement.
