Pursuant to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942 (herein called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the Gazette of the making hereof.
- 4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 1) is revoked, and the following substituted:
