Pursuant to section 3 of the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942* (herein called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the Gazette of the making hereof.
- 4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as enacted by the Motor-spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 3) is revoked, and the following substituted:—
