PURSUANT to the Medical Practitioners Act, 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners Regulations 1951.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1951.
2. The fees prescribed in the Schedule hereto shall be payable under the Medical Practitioners Act, 1950, in respect of the matters specified in that Schedule.
3. The regulations made under the Medical Practitioners Act, 1914, on the 10th day of April, 1933, and published in the *Gazette* of the 13th day of April, 1933, Volume I, at page 736, are hereby revoked.
