



**THE MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS REGULATIONS 1951,

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 18th day of December 1967

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Medical Practitioners Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Medical Practitioners Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Regulation 2 of these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1968.

(3) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in subclause (2) of this regulation, the fee for an annual practising certificate in respect of the year commencing on the 1st day of April 1968 shall be that prescribed by the Schedule to the principal regulations, as substituted by regulation 2 of these regulations.

2. New Schedule of fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
