**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 42 of the Massage Parlours Act 1978, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Massage Parlours Regulations 1979, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Massage Parlours Regulations 1979\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 8th day of October 1991.

**2. New fee substituted**—The Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Massage Parlours Regulations 1979, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by omitting from item 2 the expression “5”, and substituting the expression “10”.

**3. Goods and services tax included**—The fee prescribed by these regulations is inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations which come into force on 8 October 1991, increase from \$5 to \$10 the fee payable for the issue of a licence under the Massage Parlours Act 1978. The fee is inclusive of goods and services tax.
