PURSUANT to section 75 (c) of the Medical Practitioners Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Fees) Regulations 1985.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1985.

2. Fees—The fees prescribed in the Schedule to these regulations shall be payable under the Medical Practitioners Act 1968 in respect of the matters specified in that Schedule.

3. Transitional—Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in regulation 1 (2) of these regulations, the fee for an annual practising certificate in respect of the year commencing on the 1st day of April 1985 shall be that prescribed in the Schedule to these regulations.

4. Revocation—The Medical Practitioners (Fees) Regulations 1979* are hereby revoked.
