Pursuant to section 75 (c) of the Medical Practitioners Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Fees) Regulations 1985, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Medical Practitioners (Fees) Regulations 1985* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Fee for annual practising certificate increased—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "25", and substituting the expression "40".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The regulations increase from \$25 to \$40 the fee for an annual practising certificate under the Medical Practitioners Act 1968.
