



## THE MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS (FEES) REGULATIONS 1989

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 6th day of March 1989

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 75 (c) of the Medical Practitioners Act 1968 (as substituted by section 13 of the Medical Practitioners Amendment Act 1970), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the advice of the Minister of Health given after consultation by that Minister with the Medical Council of New Zealand, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Fees) Regulations 1989.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1989.

**2. Fees**—There shall be paid to the Medical Council of New Zealand for each matter specified in the Schedule to these regulations the fee specified in respect of that matter in the Schedule.

**3. Goods and services tax excluded**—The fees prescribed in the Schedule to these regulations are exclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

**4. Revocations**—The Medical Practitioners (Fees) Regulations 1987\* and the Medical Practitioners (Fees) Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 1†, are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*
