

# THE MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS (FEES) REGULATIONS 1990

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 12th day of March 1990

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 75 (c) of the Medical Practitioners Act 1968 (as substituted by section 13 of the Medical Practitioners Amendment Act 1970), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the advice of the Minister of Health given after consultation by that Minister with the Medical Council of New Zealand, hereby makes the following regulations.

## **REGULATIONS**

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Fees) Regulations 1990.
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1990.
- 2. Fees—There shall be paid to the Medical Council of New Zealand for each matter specified in the Schedule to these regulations the fee specified in respect of that matter in the Schedule.

- **3. Goods and services tax included**—The fees prescribed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.
- **4. Revocation**—The Medical Practitioners (Fees) Regulations 1989\* are hereby consequentially revoked.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1990, prescribe a new and increased scale of fees payable by medical practitioners to the Medical Council of New Zealand under the Medical Practitioners Act 1968.

The fees prescribed are inclusive of goods and services tax.
