# THE MOTOR-SPIRITS PRICES (TARANAKI-WELLINGTON) REGULATIONS 1937, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 4th day of December, 1940.

#### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Motor-spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-spirits Prices (Taranaki-Wellington) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-spirits Prices (Taranaki-Wellington) Regulations 1937\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the Gazette of the making thereof.†
- 4. The First Schedule of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words "Area D—Opunake-Kaponga-Toko" and the description of that area which follows those words, and substituting the following:—

#### AREA D.

#### Opunake-Kaponga-Toko.

All that area in the Taranaki and Wellington Land Districts bounded on the north and west by Area C, and again on the west by Area B, from the south-western corner of Section 46, Block XII, Cape Survey District, to the north-western corner of Section 1, Block I, Waitara Survey District; thence westerly and northerly along the sea-coast to a point on the sea-coast in line with the production of a line running between Waiiti Trig. Station and Titoki Trig. Station; thence along that line passing through Titoki Trig. Station to Waiiti Trig. Station; thence southerly along a right line to a point 40 chains due east of Purangi Postoffice; thence south-westerly along a right line to a point 40 chains due east of

Douglas Post-office; thence south-easterly along a right line to the north-western corner of the Town District of Waverley; thence along the western and southern boundaries of the Town District of Waverley to the Oturi Road; thence along the Oturi Road and the Ihupuku Road to the Wairoa Stream; thence down the Wairoa Stream to the sea-coast; thence along the sea-coast to the mouth of the Patea River; thence along a right line to the intersection of the Hukatere Road and the Patea River; thence along the Hukatere Road to the Wanganui – New Plymouth Railway line; thence along that railway-line to the Manawapou Stream; thence northerly along a right line to the south-eastern corner of the Borough of Eltham; thence northerly, westerly, and southerly along the boundaries of the Borough of Eltham to the Waingongoro River; thence along a right line to the north-eastern corner of Section 40, Block XV, Kaupokonui Survey District; thence along a right line to the north-western corner of Section 9, Block V, Waimate Survey District; thence along the road (Taikatu Road) forming the western boundary of Section 9, Block V aforesaid, to the sea; thence north-westerly along the sea-coast to the southern boundary of Area C, the place of commencement.
