THE MINING REGULATIONS, 1926, AMENDMENT NO. 6.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General.

Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Mining Act, 1926.

Date on which the regulations were made: 3rd day of February, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 11th day of February, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Mining Regulations, 1926, Amendment No. 6.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations under the Mining Act, 1926, made on the 9th day of November, 1926* (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification thereof in the *Gazette*.
- 4. Clause 108 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted:—
- "108. (1) The office of the Court shall be open to the public daily except on Sundays, Saturdays, and holidays.
- (2) The hours during which the office shall be so open shall be from 9.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.
- "(3) Nevertheless when the Clerk has to attend more offices than one he shall keep his office open on such days and hours as the Warden from time to time appoints.
- "(4) A notice of the office days and hours shall be kept posted in some conspicuous place inside and outside the office."
