THE MINING REGULATIONS 1926, AMENDMENT NO. 9

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 25th day of March, 1942.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Mining Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Mining Regulations 1926, Amendment No. 9.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations under the Mining Act, 1926, made on the 9th day of November, 1926* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification thereof in the Gazette.
- 4. Regulation 20 of the principal regulations (as replaced by Regulation 20 of the Mining Regulations 1926, Amendment No. 8) is revoked, and the following substituted:—
- "20. Labour under Mineral Leases.—The lessee shall, within six months after the date of the mineral lease, commence and thereafter during the term of the lease continually prosecute mining operations on the demised land for the specified mineral, and for that purpose shall at all times keep employed upon or in connection with the demised land and his mining operations thereon such number of workmen as are prescribed by his lease."
