

THE MEAT REGULATIONS 1940, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 22nd day of October, 1941.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Meat Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Meat Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Meat Regulations 1940* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1941.
- **4.** Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is amended as follows:—
 - (i) By revoking the item in the words and figures "For every head of pigs, 0s. 4d." in clause 12:4 thereof, and substituting therefor the following item: "For every head of pigs, 0s. 5d.".
 - (ii) By revoking the figure and symbol "2d." in clause 12:5 thereof, and substituting therefor the following figure and symbol: "3d.".
 - (iii) By revoking the figure and symbol "2d." in clause 12:6 thereof, and substituting therefor the following figure and symbol: "3d.".
 - (iv) By revoking the figure and symbol "2d." in subclause (ii) of clause 12:8 thereof, and substituting therefor the following figure and symbol: "3d.".
