**THE MOTOR-DRIVERS REGULATIONS 1940,  
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 19th day of  
November, 1947

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor-vehicles Act, 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day next following the notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is amended by adding to clause (4A) thereof, as inserted by Regulation 7 of the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 3, the following words : " unless—

- " (a) He has at any time prior to the date of his application been the holder of a licence to drive a public motor-vehicle in any of any one or more of the said classes ; and
- " (b) Satisfies the Minister that his past driving record has been satisfactory ; and
- " (c) Furnishes to the Minister a recent certificate from a medical practitioner showing that the remaining eye is of six-sixths standard without glasses and that in the opinion of the medical practitioner he is physically capable of driving safely a public motor-vehicle of any one or more of the said classes."

5. Form 5 in the Schedule to the principal regulations, as amended by clause (d) of Regulation 11 of the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 3, is hereby further amended as follows : by deleting the word "totally" in the note to item 1 thereof; and by adding the following words to that note : "unless the conditions imposed by the said clause (4A) have been satisfied."
