THE MEAT REGULATIONS 1940, AMENDMENT No. 5

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Meat Act 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1952.

2. (1) Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking clause 12 : 4 (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Meat Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 4) and substituting the following clause :—

“ 12 : 4. In addition to the foregoing fees there shall be payable in respect of stock slaughtered in an abattoir or meat-export slaughterhouse the inspection fees following, that is to say :—

“ For every head of cattle or horses	1	6
“ For every head of calves not exceeding 60 lb. dressed weight	0	1½
“ For every head of calves exceeding 60 lb. and not exceeding 100 lb. dressed weight	0	3
“ For every head of calves exceeding 100 lb. and not exceeding 250 lb. dressed weight	0	6
“ For every head of calves exceeding 250 lb. dressed weight	1	6
“ For every head of pigs	1	3
“ For every twelve (or fraction of twelve) sheep, lambs, or goats	1	6.”

(2) The Meat Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 4, are hereby consequentially revoked.

3. Regulation 12 : 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "less than £10", and substituting the words "less than £15".

4. Regulation 12 : 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) By omitting the words "the sum of £10", and substituting the words "the sum of £15":

(b) By omitting the words "an average charge of £1", and substituting the words "an average charge of £1 10s."

5. Regulation 12 : 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (i), and substituting the following subclause :—

"(i) Subject to the provisions of subclause (ii) of this regulation, there shall be payable in respect of stock slaughtered in any rural slaughterhouse the inspection fees following, that is to say :—

"Where the number of stock slaughtered in any one period of three months ended 30 September, 31 December, 31 March, and 30 June—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations substitute new scales of inspection fees in respect of stock slaughtered in an abattoir or meat-export slaughterhouse or in a rural slaughterhouse.
