

THE MEAT REGULATIONS 1969, AMENDMENT NO. 1

Pursuant to the Meat Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1970.
- 2. Abattoir, export slaughterhouse, and rural slaughterhouse fees— The Sixth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking clauses 8 and 9, and substituting the following clauses:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations substitute a new scale of meat inspection fees for abattoirs, export slaughterhouses, and rural slaughterhouses.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 29 October 1970. These regulations are administered in the Department of Agriculture.
