ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of June 1982

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 49 of the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 16, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1982.
- 2. Abattoir, export slaughterhouse, and rural slaughterhouse fees—The Sixth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking clauses 8 and 9 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 14, and amended by regulation 2 of the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 15), and substituting the following clauses:
 - "8. Abattoir and export slaughterhouse fees (reg. 274)— For every head of—

Cattle (including calves exceeding 27 kg dressed weight) or horses 2.16
Calves, not exceeding 27 kg dressed weight ... 0.10
Pigs 2.01
Sheep, lambs, and goats 0.01

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the meat inspection fees payable on cattle and horses on and from 1 July 1982. The increase is from 24 cents to \$2.16 a head.
