PURSUANT to section 49 of the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 17, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1982.

2. Increase in inspection fees for pigs—Clauses 8 and 9 of the Sixth Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 16) are hereby amended by omitting from the item relating to pigs the expression “2.01”, and substituting the expression “2.26”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the slaughterhouse inspection fees on pigs on and from 1 October 1982. The increase is from \$2.01 to \$2.26 a head.
