PURSUANT to section 49 of the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 18, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Regulations 1969\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1983.

**2. Abattoir, export slaughterhouse, and rural slaughterhouse fees**—The Sixth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking clauses 8 and 9 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 16, and amended by regulation 2 of the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 17), and substituting the following clauses:

**3. Revocations**—The Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 16, and the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 17 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations increase the meat inspection fees payable on cattle and horses on and from 1 January 1983. The increase is from \$2.16 a head to \$2.66 a head.
