

THE MEAT REGULATIONS 1969, AMENDMENT NO. 5

Pursuant to section 83 of the Meat Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Abattoir and export slaughterhouse fees—The Sixth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from clause 8 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 3, and amended by regulation 2 of the Meat Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 4) the item relating to pigs, and substituting the following item:

"Pigs 0.935".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase from \$0.89 to \$0.935 a head the meat inspection levy payable in respect of pigs killed in abattoirs and export slaughterhouses.
