HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to the Marriage Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Marriage Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marriage Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after

the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. New fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
