ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 12th day of October 1981

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. D. MACINTYRE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 64 of the Marriage Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Marriage Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marriage Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. New forms substituted—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking forms 14 and 15, and substituting the forms 14 and 15 set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

CERTIFICATE OF ORDER DISSOLVING A MARRIAGE

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe, consequent on the passing of the Family Proceedings Act 1980 and the amendment made by that Act to the Marriage Act 1955, a new form of certificate of order dissolving a marriage and a new form of certificate of order declaring a marriage to be void ab initio.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936. Date of notification in Gazette: 15 October 1981. This order is administered in the Department of Justice.
