**THE MINING REGULATIONS 1981,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 22nd day of June 1987

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Mining Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Mining Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Mining Regulations 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 26th day of June 1987.

2. Increasing rent payable under prospecting licences—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 8, and substituting the following regulation:

“8. (1) The annual rent payable under a prospecting licence shall be—

“(a) For the initial term of the licence, \$2 per hectare or part of a hectare or \$40, whichever is the greater:

“(b) On renewal of the licence, \$4 per hectare or part of a hectare or \$80, whichever is the greater.

“(2) The rent shall be paid yearly in advance.

“(3) Every application for a prospecting licence or for the renewal of a prospecting licence shall be accompanied by the first year’s rent.

“(4) If a prospecting licence is for any reason not granted or renewed the rent shall be refunded.”

3. Increasing rent payable under mining licences—Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$5”, and substituting the expression “\$10”.

4. Increasing fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations come into force on 26 June 1987.

Regulations 2 and 3 increase the rent payable under prospecting and mining licences.

Regulation 4 increases the fees payable under the principal regulations and also fixes fees payable under sections 103D, 123, and 145 of the Mining Act 1971.
