THE MEAT (SURIMI) REGULATIONS 1987, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 49 (1) (z) and 50 (1) of the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title, commencement, and expiry—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat (Surimi) Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat (Surimi) Regulations 1987* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

(3) These regulations shall expire with the 15th day of November 1987.

2. Expiry of principal regulations—Regulation 1 (3) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “30th day of September”, and substituting the expression “15th day of November”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations postpone until 15 November 1987 the expiry of the Meat (Surimi) Regulations 1987, which exempt from the licensing requirements of the Meat Act 1981 all registered fishing vessels being used for processing hoki into surimi. Surimi is washed, minced fish, frozen into blocks. The regulations were previously expressed to expire at the end of the 1986-87 fishing season (30 September 1987).
