PURSUANT to section 64 of the Marriage Act 1955, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Marriage (Fees) Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marriage (Fees) Regulations 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Further fees prescribed—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following items:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after notification in the Gazette, prescribe fees for the provision by the Registrar-General of copies of indexes of information recorded under the Marriage Act 1955 or the Acts that preceded it. Until the passage of the Marriage Amendment Act 1993, which came into force on 1 July 1993, it was not possible to obtain copies of such indexes.
