ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Meat (Payments) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Meat (Payments) Regulations 1990\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1990.

**2. Fees**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule, and substituting the schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1990, increase by \$2 three fees payable under the Meat Act 1981. The effect is that all fees are now set at a level intended to recover in full the costs to the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries of the matters to which the fees relate.
